Subjective age, i.e., how old or young individuals feel, is a growing area of research in gerontology. In this talk Prof. Yannick Stephan will present research on the role of subjective age as a novel, alternative biopsychosocial marker of aging. In particular, he will detail recent findings and future directions on the determinants and implications of subjective age for a range of outcomes, spanning from biological functioning to dementia and mortality, independent of chronological age.
