"COVID-19 pandemic: Implications for older adults' mental health and mental health care"

We are announcing a special issue on "Corona pandemic: Implications for older adults' mental health and mental health care" to be published in 2021. We expect original manuscript submissions that evidence high quality, innovative work on incorporating approaches from geriatric psychiatry, clinical psychology and social gerontology. We invite authors to submit original research reports, clinical case reports as well as conceptual papers addressing implications of the COVID-19 pandemic for older people's mental health and mental health care, including the further development of the field of geriatric psychiatry and clinical geropsychology in the wake of the pandemic. Original reports using qualitative methodology are also welcome.

We invite authors to submit manuscripts by **January 1, 2021** via <https://www.editorialmanager.com/geropsych/>. Manuscripts should be prepared in accordance with the journal's author guidelines available in the downloads section below.
